Robin gave announcements about budget that was just signed:

New courthouse – 18 stories high and 54 courthouses, California Indian heritage center – 43 acres on the riverfront – will replace Sutter's Fort museum. Will be built with help from tribal representatives. Lower American River Parkway – add improvements and clean up, restore habitat and protect ecosystem, PowerHouse Science Center (STEM education), UC Davis Aggie Square satellite campus, described as a satellite campus because UC Davis has too many students (?) Refugee career pathways (#1 center for refugees), engineers, nurses, people with high degrees) funding going into refugee resettlement fees.

\$18M funding for homelessness. Emergency and long term shelters, allocation for Yolo County as well.

Levy improvements – largest flood zone in the nation. \$195M for flood control, Natomas, American River Commons, improvements along dam areas and riverbanks.

Cal Expo - \$15M to make improvements to Fairgrounds

Question: What do we do now?

There is some interest in forming a more formal organization. How much interest is there in forming a more formal structure? Some neighbors talk about forming a non-profit. Guidelines can serve as base to organization.

If we get too structured we may run into more problems.

Understand what the purpose would be of building a bigger structure. What purpose would that serve? Is there anything to solve?

Guidelines have improved on communication channels. Document has defined who can be leaders.

Outline pros/cons of board structure

Table committee until more interest. May be good to review yearly, in January meeting to prepare for upcoming year.

Three most important goals for the neighborhood update

Safety – Table traffic and safety and continued discussion of top three priorities for next meeting. Work on formalizing action plan for next steps

Park – Bathroom doors, remodel, restroom remodel and system for opening restrooms. May be time to try opening the restrooms up again. 4 pin code lockbox. Rent a key from the city.

Lighting – Steve and Rose walked down one side of SF Blvd. Continue communicating with neighbors about what they would like to see. Where do the signatures happen? Steve and Rose will continue communicating with neighbors.
