**Committee Updates**

- Finance/Treasury
  - February
    - Starting Balance: \$4,714.23
    - Expenses: \$137.50 (Monthly Meeting, Canva)
    - Income: \$0
    - End Balance: \$4,576.73
  - Tahoe Park Neighborhood Association (TPNA) approved continuing the partnership of TPNA being CHNA's fiscal sponsor
- Aggie Square Community Partnership (ASCP)
  - Applications for the Aggie Square Community Fund have closed
  - ASCP is reviewing and is slated to award grants mid-April
- Colonial Park
  - Kickball field to be worked on by City
    - May 16<sup>th</sup> 9am – 12pm will be a community workday to paint the backstop and benches
  - Request for Capital Asset Purchase
    - Park Committee is requesting up to \$500 to purchase items that will help to maintain the park and for event use (i.e. rakes, brooms, dustpans, hoses, extension cord, etc)
